INTRODUCCION

Bien es sabido que uno de los grandes problemas de nuestra especialización es la falta de bibliografía, por eso la búsqueda de referencias resulta frecuentemente penosa, ya que además no contamos con los recursos adecuados para ello. La compilación que aquí se presenta está dirigida para auxiliar en sus actividades a los maestros, estudiantes e interesados en la Biblioteconomía.

Este trabajo está basado, principalmente, en materiales existentes en la Biblioteca Penrose de la Universidad de Denver, Denver, Colorado. Se trata de obras consultadas personalmente, aunque una minoría fueron referencias indirectas.

De ninguna manera significa que estamos recomendando este listado para su adquisición, porque esto debe estar en relación con el nivel y necesidades específicas del interesado. El nivel de la mayoría de las obras mostradas son para licenciatura y maestría. Por razones obvias el 90 o 95% de la compilación comprenden obras en inglés. Se sugiere que se complemente este trabajo con otros cuyo contenido sea preferentemente en español.

Como se podrá apreciar, se incluyen muy pocas citas de fechas antiguas; sin embargo, son obras que por varios motivos se consideran tradicionales o bien, simplemente que pueden tener determinado mérito.

El trabajo está dividido en 6 áreas: 1.- Introducción a la Biblioteconomía (abarca: historia de las bibliotecas; principios, procedimientos y filosofía de la biblioteconomía; historia de los libros; etc.). 2.- Administración (cubre: principios de organización y administración; administración por tipos de bibliotecas y algunos trabajos relacionados al tópico). 3.- Servicios al Público (contiene: referencia; circulación: préstamo interbibliotecario; educación del usuario y guías generales). 4.- Procesos técnicos (incluye: Selección y adquisición: catalogación y clasificación: reproducción; reparación y encuadernación. 5.- Documentación (comprende: ciencias de la información, centros de información y documentación: indizado, resúmenes; almacenamiento y recuperación de la información: diseminación. 6.- Varios (en donde se anotaron obras de temas generales como, manuales de estilo, microformas, publicaciones periódicas y seriadas, audiovisuales y bibliotecas infantiles). Se incluyó un Anexo con el fin de enlistar algunas otras obras que se encontraron posteriormente, así como para proporcionar varios títulos de publicaciones periódicas. El número de clasificación que se anota entre paréntesis en ciertas entradas corresponde al asignado en la Biblioteca Penrose.

Inicialmente el presente trabajo era exclusivamente para propósitos personales, por lo cual no tiene ninguna presunción de ser analítico ni mucho menos comprensivo. Sin embargo, ante la sugerencia de algunas personas se intentó darle cierta ordenación, pensando que posiblemente también le pueda ser de utilidad a alguien mas.
